After putting on a master-class for turning a one-day scandal into a two-week public relations nightmare, the Blue Jays finally went out and did what they should have done in the first place.

Eleven days removed from Anthony Bass posting a video that labelled support for the LGBTQ community as "demonic" and "satanic," the Jays dropped Bass from the roster. The veteran reliever was designated for assignment prior to Friday night's 3-2 loss to the Minnesota Twins, which coincided with the official start of the club's Pride Weekend.
